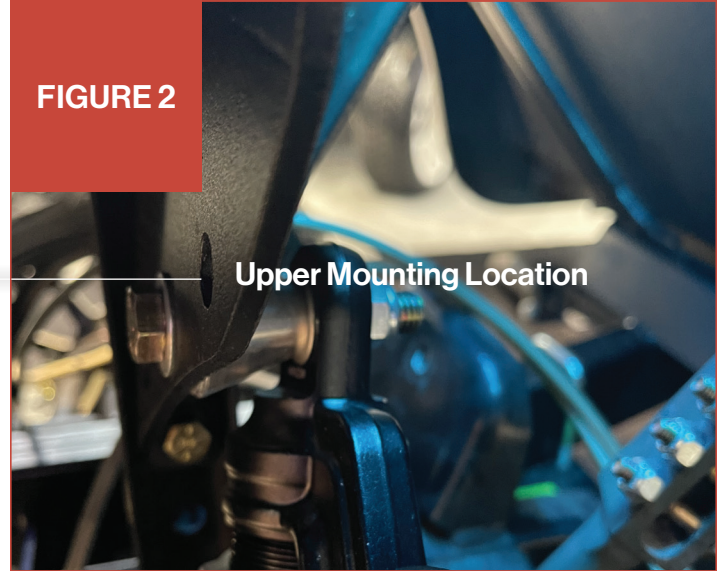

- 1 Remove existing shocks to be replaced and retain original hardware.
- 2 Locate the stock mounting locations and install new long-travel shocks using the existing hardware that was retained as shown above in **FIGURE 1**.

- 3 **ADJUSTMENT**: The top valve allows for compression adjustment. The lower valve allows for shock rebound adjustment.
